Ms. Kilgore comes from ION Geophysical Corporation and has worked for other companies such as Chevron and the US Army Corps of Engineers. As a safety rep Grace worked in the Houston Public Works Department which has been awarded the prestigious American Public Works Association (APWA) re-accreditation designation. She was on the team that produced the documentation for accreditation.
