



PURPOSE & ELIGIBILITY

The ASSP Chapter SPY award is an honor acknowledging the dedication and outstanding contributions of a member to a specific Chapter. To be eligible nominees must:

- Be a Professional Member, Member or International Member in good standing of their Chapter and the Society.
- Not have received this award within the past five (5) years.
- Be engaged in full-time employment in the profession of protecting people, property and the environment.

Nominees are not eligible if they are currently serving as a member of the Board of Directors or the Chapter Awards Committee, or have been elected an ASSP fellow.

Each year, ASSP honors members who advance the safety profession, and who produce excellent results within their own organizations or within an ASSP member community. Such recognition is both personally fulfilling and professionally rewarding.

Outstanding Safety Educator

Government Affairs Update

OSHA Trade Release

Deparment of Labor completes restructuring of OSHA regional offices, adds new Birmingham region to improve operations

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration has completed changes to restructure its regional operations and create a new region in Birmingham, Alabama. OSHA's intent with the new Birmingham Region is to make workplaces safer and healthier by giving workers a voice and promoting equitable quality service with commitment and respect.

Among the changes is the creation of a new region based in Birmingham to serve Alabama, Arkansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee and the Florida Panhandle.

OSHA has combined operations that had been designated as Regions 9 and 10 to create a new San Francisco Region, to improve the ability of OSHA to deploy resources and serve workers in the new region.

The agency will now also use geographic designations to identify its regions rather than numerals. OSHA has <u>renamed the regions</u> using the following designations:

ANSI/ASSP A10.48 New Leadership Announced

ASSP recently confirmed a new leadership team for the A10.48 Subgroup Committee. Kathy Stieler, NATE's director of safety, health and compliance, will chair the committee, and Dominique Valdez, a member of NATE's board, will serve as committee liaison. This committee oversees development of ANSI/ASSP A10.48-2023, "Standard – Criteria for Safety Practices with the Construction, Demolition, Modification and Maintenance of Communications Structures," which serves as the industry's "playbook" and provides comprehensive safety guidance for the entire tower construction, service and maintenance activities.
